

Lee High School Parent Teacher Student Association (PTSA) Scholarship

Robert E. Lee High School Parent Teacher Student Association (PTSA) will offer two scholarships to Lee seniors to assist with their post-secondary education plans. Consideration will be given to a Lee 12th grader entering a college, university, or training facility. ***The student must be a PTSA member*.**

Scholarship Criteria

- Academic Achievement (GPA and Academic Awards)
- Extracurricular Activities
- Volunteer Work with the PTSA and/or for other Lee High School sponsored events
- Community Involvement (outside Lee High School)
- Written Narrative (250-300 words) answering the question below (a typed response is preferred)

Reflect upon your years at Lee HS, what have you learned about what it takes to be a good citizen at school and in your community. How do you think these lessons learned will serve you as you move onto life after high school?

The recipient must:

- Be graduating from Lee in June 2019
- Become a PTSA member no later than February 1, 2019. Membership fee is \$10
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or better – please provide 7th semester academic transcript
- Submit the application and essay no later than May 1, 2019.

Amount of Scholarship

The Lee High School PTSA will award up to 2 scholarships each in the amount of \$1,000 each payable to the institution of higher learning.

Selection Process

The Lee High School PTSA Selection Committee will be responsible for reviewing all scholarship applications and making a determination on who will be the final winner or winners of the PTSA Scholarships. The PTSA Scholarship Selection Committee will be made up of a designated team of PTSA members who do not have children applying for the scholarship. The selection will be a blind process, i.e., the selection committee will not know the names of the candidates until after the applications have been reviewed and winners selected. Notification of the Committee's selection will be announced at the Senior Awards 2019. Winners need not be present to accept the award. All applicants must agree that the decision of the PTSA Scholarship Committee is final and not open to appeal.
